This policy and any other documents referred to in it describes the personal information that we collect from you, or that you provide on this website www.univerteam.com (which may link to other Univerteam websites, www.univercommerce.com, www.univerwebs.com, www.univerads.com, www.univerapp.com) and how that information may be used or disclosed by us.

This Privacy Policy relates to all information we collect between you and this Website and us.

All Univerteam websites contain privacy policies, which are equal to this Privacy Policy.

Please read the following carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your personal information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our Website. By using or accessing our Website, you agree to this privacy policy. Children Under the Age of 18

Our Website is not intended for children under 18 years of age. No one under age 18 may provide any personal information to or on the Website.

COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

The user's identification data collection will be done by filling in an online registration form and this will be done in accordance with the strictest security rules.

The information collected is entered into the computer system, where it is treated and automatically processed in the terms approved by the National Data Protection Commission (CNPD). The information is intended for Univerteam service management and interaction with the affiliates.

Univerteam guarantees the registered affiliate the possibility to access his personal information through his/her "back office" and to review and correct information.

Usage Details, IP Addresses, Cookies and Other Technologies

- **Usage Details and IP Addresses.** As you navigate through the Website, we may also collect details of your visits to our Website, including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, logs and other communication data, whether this is required for our own billing purposes or otherwise and the resources that you access, as well as information about your computer and Internet connection, including your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about our users' equipment, browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.
- **Cookies.** For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general Internet usage by using cookies. A cookie is a small file stored on the hard drive of your computer. Most browsers allow you to refuse to accept cookies by activating the appropriate browser settings. You can usually adjust browser settings to notify you of cookie placement, decline certain cookies, or block cookies completely.
